As many of you may have heard, Governor Walz has officially extended Distance Learning for the remainder of the 2019-2020 school year. Executive order 20-41 includes a massive amount of information that needs to be examined. Stay tuned while we continue to interpret the information provided.

The Jaguar Kid Connection will remain open as usual. As the Stay At Home order is lifted May 4, we hope to see many of our children return to child care. Please let your child's teacher know if we should expect your child to start back the week of May 4. Fees will be applied and there will not be bussing. Families that are currently receiving care only need to let your child's teacher know if there will be changes to your services.

The date that was originally set for kindergarten round-up has come and gone. While we will likely not be able to reschedule this in the school building, we will be working on some sort of online presentation for the class of 2033. Stay tuned for more information.

At this time, we are still hopeful to be able to provide some variation of summer school programming. We will be sure to keep in touch with families regarding the final details as they are set.

Looking into the near future, we want to be clear that Friday, May 1, is not a school day. This day will be used for teachers to prepare for continuing with Distance Learning through the end of the school year. Please continue to provide a quiet place and a supportive environment for your child to do school work and attend online seminars with their teachers. As the weather gets nice (hopefully) this will become more difficult for all of us.
