Tally marks cut and paste

Complete the Cut and Paste Tally marks paper. Optional extended practice: write a number and then show that number using tally marks on the back of your completed worksheet. Make sure to keep the tally marks neat and that there are only 5 in a group.

Focus: Number value, representation of numbers with tally marks

Play 1 or 2 digit Top-it

Place the stack of cards face down between the two players. Players take turns turning over a card reading the number aloud. The player with the larger number keeps the 2 cards. If both players have the same number, the players turn over another card and the larger number wins all the cards. The player with the most cards at the end of the game wins.

Focus: Number identification, comparing numbers, ordering.

Read a Story

Read a story with your child. Talk about what happened in the beginning, the middle, and the end of the story and identify the characters and setting of the story. Then draw a picture of your favorite part. Identify the characters and setting of the story.

Focus: Sequencing, story comprehension, retelling a story using pictures.



YOGA FREEZE DANCE

Dance & exercise along with the video. Challenge: Stay frozen and silent during the yoga poses.

Focus: Body movement and self-regulation.



ELA GAME

Ginger Bread Syllables. Clap out the words to find the correct number of syllables. Cut and sort the pieces, accordingly. Color them if you have time!

Focus: fine motor, pre-reading skills, sorting, time on task



Help with Holiday Gifts

Plan and list the people who are on the gift list. Work with a grown up to help prepare gifts by writing on tags, helping cut the wrapping paper, helping fold and tape the wrapping paper, etc.

Focus: Planning & completing a task. Writing, cutting, collaboration, counting



Santa BUMP

Roll 2 dice and add them to find the total (sum). Cover that reindeer with a game marker. (coins work great!) The other person takes a turn and if they roll the same sum they can BUMP your marker off. Roll the same sum twice to lock in the marker. Start with 10 pieces-the 1st person to place all their pieces wins.

Focus: addition, taking turns, counting



Sticker Art

Use the stickers to create a winter character. Create a setting for your story out of supplies from home. Make up a story with your creation as the main character and tell it to another person.

Focus: Creativity, verbal communication, and fine motor



OUTDOOR SCAVENGER HUNT

Use the attached sheet to go on a scavenger hunt outside.

Focus: Outdoor time, large motor, tracing, categorizing, counting, recall and retell events in an activity.
