In our most recent surveys of staff, students, and families, results reflected a strong sense of pride and connection to BBE Schools. Families expressed high satisfaction with communication, caring staff, and the supportive school environment. Students reported feeling safe and valued, noting positive relationships with

teachers and peers. Staff shared appreciation for collaboration, professional growth opportunities, and community support. Feedback also highlighted areas for continued improvement, including expanding academic opportunities. Overall, the survey results affirm that BBE is a place where students, staff, and families feel engaged and supported.

The School Readiness program implemented the Work Sampling Systems to calculate pre and post data for tracking PreK readiness. 92% (48 of 55) of Kindergarten-eligible students are served in our School Readiness program and 8% (4 of 48) of learners were recommended to repeat preschool for the 2024-2025 school year to ensure they are prepared for Kindergarten. 
